"Jadeite cabbage with insects and banded jasper resembling a slab of meat" Exhibition News

With verdant green leaves and white stalks carved from jadeite, this artifact resembles a real bokchoy cabbage, symbolizing purity and innocence. On top of the cabbage are two insects, an auspicious symbol of having many children and grandchildren.

Qing Dynasty

Banded jasper resembling a slab of meat

This artifact is made of natural minerals that have been skillfully sculpted by craftsmen, with tiny holes drilled and dyed on its surface, creating multi-layered textures that are like pork belly soaked in soy sauce and then boiled to perfection. It looks delicious!

A lovely and vibrant jade in the form of a duck with rounded rumps. Variations in the color of the duck can be discerned from the brown head and feet to its body's original jade color. Clearly, the jade duck had been dyed by craftsmen.

The white porcelain baby shaped pillow serves as an auspicious symbol of having many children and grandchildren

This is a movable object with inner and outer layers. When the neck of the bottle is turned, the inner bottle rotates accordingly, so the goldfish painted on the inner side can be well seen through the opening and closing of the outer

bottle, amidst the aquatic plants and fallen flowers, thereby creating a stunning scene.

Lady figurines were one of the most popular burial objects in the Tang Dynasty. The lady figure is full-bodied with a rounded face, and has long and narrow eyebrows and eyes, representing the norm of female beauty in the Tang Dynasty and presenting the realistic styles of the Tang Dynasty.

The 18-layered ivory sphere is a planet of its own. Carved from a single piece of elephant ivory, each individual layer can move freely on its own, highlighting the ingenuity and precision of the artisan's carving skills.


Shilin Night Market







Inheriting the tradition of the jade seal as a symbol of legitimacy, this jade seal embodies the authority and significance of imperial rule. In the 24th year of Qianlong's reign (1759), following the pacification of Xinjiang, Qianlong, inspired by the belief that "those who obey the heavens will prosper," commissioned the engraving of several jade seals bearing the inscription "Xintian Zhuren".

This cultural relic is a wine cup used by the Qing Dynasty emperor during the New Year's Day opening ceremony. Crafted from gold, it features Kui dragon-shaped handles, elephant-head-shaped feet, and a body adorned with green enamel, pearls, rubies, and sapphires.

The trunk and tail of the fish are rising upwards, with its bottom end depicting the image of roaring waves, thus vividly portraying a fish leaping out of the water. At a closer look, it is clear that the head of the fish is shaped like a dragon, which is traditionally an auspicious sign of a carp attempting to leap over the Dragon Gate.

Its vibrant color and coral undertones convey a sense of steadiness and joy.

A single-handled kettle is used for pouring tea into teacups. The powder of tea leaves is first placed into the teacups, and then water is boiled in the kettle and poured into the teacups to brew the powdered tea leaves.






Places to Visit in Chiayi and Tainan






